By submission, the artist attests that the artwork is his/her own work and the artist has rights necessary to make this submission. The deadline to apply is by 5:00 p.m. on March 11, 2018. Selected artists will be notified by March 18, 2018.

Artwork selected for display in April/June show must be delivered, ready to hang, between March 22 and March 28, 2018. Please note that your art must have wire on the back so we can hang it from our picture molding. Items must be available for display through June 30.

Deliver artwork in person to The Winterville Center at 371 N. Church Street, Winterville, Georgia. Hours are Monday through Friday, 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. If using a shipping service (USPS, UPS, FedEx), deliver to Winterville City Hall, 125 N. Church Street, Winterville, GA 30683.

Artwork can be made available for sale. No commission will be charged on sales. However, if you wish to donate a portion of the sale, you can give it to the Winterville Heritage Foundation to go toward the renovation of the Winterville Auditorium.

All artwork must be picked up between July 1 and July 15 at 371 N. Church Street, Winterville.

The following information applies to the artist whose work is selected as the 2018 Featured Artwork:

Selection as the Featured Artwork gives us the right to reproduce the image on souvenirs and in publications without remuneration. All use will be credited to the artist.

Artist agrees to assist the Winterville Marigold Festival in providing artwork in a digital format suitable for reproduction.

Booth Space Information: Booth space is 10' x 10'. Artist must provide his/her own tent, tables, and all other booth apparatus. For the safety of all vendors and your artwork, please bring appropriate tent weights (not ropes & stakes or anchors). Not all booths have electricity available. If electricity is needed, please let us know.

Festival hours are 9:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. Early breakdown is discouraged. Vehicular access to the site is not available until 5:00 p.m. Artist must arrive either Friday, May 11 between 5:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. OR Saturday, May 12 between 5:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. **Due to road closures, you must arrive no later than 7:00 a.m. on Saturday.** All vehicles must be removed from the vendor area by 8:15 a.m.

Please do not leave debris, boxes, etc., at your space when you depart.

The City of Winterville and Winterville Marigold Festival, Inc., or its agents or assigns are not responsible for any personal injury to the exhibitor or its agent or for the safety of the exhibits against theft, fire damage, accidents, or other causes. The artist is encouraged to take all steps, measures, and precautions as necessary to protect its agents, exhibits, displays, and property against all possible injury, damage, loss, or destruction, during set-up and breakdown, during festival hours, and during non-festival hours.
